RIGHT TO PROPERTY – lack of legal certainty in case-law

- Request to the Civil College of the Supreme Court of Cassation to streamline the diverse case-law on the following:
- 1. "Which is the final time at which a co-owner taking part in a public sale as a bidder may exercise their right to buy the property at the highest price offered under Article 505, para 2 Civil Procedure Code (CPC) read in conjunction with Article 354 CPC?"
- The Civil College of the Supreme Court of Cassation did not initiate an interpretative judgement case at the request of the Ombudsman of the Republic of Bulgaria.
