RIGHTS IN ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS – lack of legal certainty in case-law

- Request to the Civil College of the Supreme Court of Cassation to streamline the diverse case-law on the following:
- 1. "Does the failure to pay the fees which judicial enforcement agents collect as per the Fees and Expenses Tariff under the Private Enforcement Agents Act to administer a complaint submitted constitute grounds of irregularity of the claim submitted against the actions of a private enforcement agent within the meaning of Article 262 CPC?"
- The Civil College of the Supreme Court of Cassation did not initiate an interpretative judgement case at the request of the Ombudsman of the Republic of Bulgaria.
